Dates

You have at most two attempts for passing the exam. The first attempts of the oral exams take place on February 5, 6, 14 an 15. The second attempts take place from March 25 to March 30.

Registration

To participate the exams you have to be registered on BASIS. Moreover, it is mandatory to book a personal appointment via the booking tool in the eCampus course. The booking for the first attempt will be closed on January 28.

If you only like to use the second attempt in March, the first attempt will be accounted as failed. In this case please write an e-mail to manuel[dot]esser[at]uni-bonn.de because we formally have to give you an appointment also in February.

After the booking is closed, we will set up and inform you about the final schedule via e-mail. You are then asked to confirm by an informal reply. We reserve the right that the final schedule varies from the appointments you have booked by minor changes (around 1 hour). So keep the day of your exam free and regularly check your @uni-bonn.de mail-account.
